History	From October 1866, the Broughton Creek Literary and Debating Society met in the old school in Pulman Street, Berry (until 1874 known as Broughton Creek). A building between Queen and Princess Streets was used until 1906 when a new school of Arts was opened on the corner of Princess and Alexandra Streets.
