History	The Australian Vietnam Society (AVS) was a national organisation which fostered international solidarity between Australia and Vietnam. One of its main aims was to lobby for the lifting of sanctions against Vietnam. The South Coast AVS produced a newsletter, held irregular meetings, and raised funds for the Vietnam solidarity work. It maintained links with the South Coast Labor Council, the Communist Party and the Wollongong University community.
