

**D46            Clothing and Allied Trades' Union of Australia - New South Wales Branch**

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History	The Federated Clothing Trades of the Commonwealth of Australia Industrial Union of Employees was formed in 1907 to take advantage of the provisions of the newly introduced Commonwealth Arbitration Act. A NSW branch of the Association was formed in May 1917. In 1922 the title was altered to the Federated Clothing and Allied Trades' Union. The title was again changed in 1924 when it became the Amalgamated Clothing and Allied Trades' Union. The present form of the title was adopted in 1947.

 The inaugural meeting of the Association was held on 8 February 1875. The Association was registered under the provisions of the NSW Trade Union Act in October 1882 and provided the NSW nucleus of the Federated Clothing Trades when that union was formed in 1907.

This body had been established in 1907 and a NSW Branch had been formed in May 1917.

In some instances, lists bear the letterhead of the employing company suggesting that contributions were collected by the employer.
